ETHICAL CODE OF STUDENT

I. GENERAL REGULATIONS

- 1.1. The ethical code of the student (hereinafter referred to as "Code") defines the moral guidelines in the behavior of students of the Institution "Salymbekov University" (hereinafter referred to as the University), based on the generally recognized norms of ethics, morality, morality, respect for colleagues, the state and society in general.
- 1.2. The code is aimed at creating the most comfortable conditions for study, a favorable psychological climate in the educational environment of the university.
- 1.3. The main goal of the implementation of this Code is to educate the corporate culture of the university student community.
- 1.4. Each student, fulfilling the norms of this Code, contributes to strengthening the image and business reputation of the University .
- 1.5. The student must comply with the Code not only during his stay at the departments, clinical sites, university campus, but also outside of it.

II. BASIC MORAL PRINCIPLES OF STUDENT

- 2.1. The student in his activities is guided by the following basic moral principles:
- humane treatment of people;
- respect for the rights, honor and dignity of the individual;
- decency;
- honesty;
- by mercy;
- responsibility for the assumed obligations;
- adherence to principles.
- 2.2. The training activities with students are taking university and must follow the following moral and ethical rules:
 - 2.2.1. In educational activities, the student:
 - seeking in-depth knowledge in the professional field: good faith teaches camping, taking a part in the research work;
 - uses every opportunity to replenish knowledge and acquire practical skills in the chosen specialty;
 - does not violate discipline during the educational process, does not use extraneous and distracting objects (communications, entertainment, gadgets, etc.) in practical classes, lectures.
 - must be punctual and show up for class on time. A late student may not be allowed to attend classes if he has not warned the head of the group or the teacher directly about this .
 - fulfills all the teacher's requirements for the educational process.

2.2.2. In behavior the student:

- takes an example from the best teachers of the University , his behavior must correspond to the high title of a doctor;
- Respectfully treats the teachers and staff of the University and, upon meeting and at the entrance of the teacher into the classroom, he greets him standing;
- observes ethical standards in communicating with other students, does not allow any form of humiliation of honor and dignity, physical and mental violence against a person;
- seeks to create a healthy microclimate in the team, does not allow discrimination based on sex of the individual, social, national, religious and other signs.
- shows respect for the customs and traditions of representatives of different peoples, takes into account the cultural and other characteristics of ethnic groups and religious confessions;
- tries to lead a healthy lifestyle;
- respects the tradition of the University as well, protects the property of the University and , following the cleanliness and order around him outside the University but always remember

that he is a representative of the University as well and trying not to drop the honor and dignity of his misconduct;

- recognizes as necessary and useful any activity aimed at strengthening the student senate system, developing student creative activity (scientific and educational, sports, artistic, etc.), at improving the corporate culture and image of the University a.
- 2.3. During the lesson in laboratories, offices and during industrial practice, the student should use only those tools, devices and other devices that are indicated by the leader of the lesson, handle them carefully and comply with labor protection, safety and fire safety requirements. Students are prohibited from taking out objects and various equipment from laboratories, educational and other premises without the permission of the University administration.
- 2.4. In appearance, the student:
- in the clothes of students, it is strongly recommended to avoid details that emphasize belonging to the subculture (an abundance of metal chains, pins, rivets, etc.), you must not come to the University in torn clothes, pants and tracksuits (including as a style clothes);
- the medical uniform symbolizes the purity of the doctor's thoughts, strictness in the performance of their professional duties. A student should follow the commandment of the great Hippocrates that doctors should "keep themselves clean, have good clothes, for all this is usually pleasant for patients";
- must comply with the rules regarding wearing a medical uniform while staying at the departments, clinical bases of the University;

The medical form implies:

- white gown and medical cap, clean, ironed;
- removable footwear with stable, soft soles;
- wearing other headdresses in the premises of clinics and departments is not allowed.

In addition to the medical form, the following requirements are imposed on the appearance:

- hair should be tucked neatly under the medical cap;
- nails are clean, cut short;
- you should not use bright, voluminous jewelry and provocative makeup;
- at the entrance to the buildings of the University and to the clinical bases, the student is obliged to put himself in proper shape. The lack of an established medical form (or partial absence) is considered a violation of discipline;
- wearing a medical uniform is regulated by the specifics of the discipline and the internal routine of the departments;
- in public catering points, as well as in public places, the student must be in ordinary clothes, without a medical uniform.
- 2.5. Since students are doing university and are required to consider their duty to fight all forms of academic dishonesty, including:
- cheating and passing knowledge control procedures by dummies;
- deceiving the teacher and disrespectful attitude towards him;
- falsification of documents directly or indirectly related to studying at the University;
- absenteeism and lateness;
- skipping training sessions or part of them without a valid reason. In order to improve the quality of mastering the disciplines provided in the curriculum , the University reserves the right to impose fines for missing classes .
- 2.6. University students should consider it unacceptable for themselves:
- -use, manufacture and distribution of any narcotic substances;
- -use of obscene and swear words and expressions of speech;
- -smoking on the territory of the University in the wrong places;
- -use of alcoholic beverages and being drunk on the territory of the University;
- non-observance of generally accepted norms of morality and ethics, including reprehensible behavior in public places;
- rudeness and rudeness in relation to students, teachers and employees of the University;

- -various forms of public expression of aggression;
- -sexual harassment;
- violation of freedom of movement, speech, assembly;
- illegal carrying or possession of weapons, explosive substances.

III. BASIC RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS STUDENT

3.1. University students have the right to:

- respect for their human dignity, free expression of their own views and beliefs, participation in public organizations whose activities do not violate the rights of internal regulations;
- transition to continuing education according to another professional educational program or to another educational institution in the manner determined by the regulatory legal acts of the Kyrgyz Republic;
- to receive additional paid educational services, incl. on individual educational programs provided at the University;
- submit their work for publication, including in the publications of the University, take part in research work, participate in conferences, exhibitions and other public events;
- elect and be elected to the student senate of the University in accordance with this Charter, and local regulations of the University;
- 3.2. Students of higher education institutions are obliged to:
 - to acquire knowledge, to fulfill in a timely manner all types of tasks provided for by the curriculum and educational programs of the university;
 - attend classes provided for in the schedule in accordance with the curriculum. Missing classes for a good reason must be confirmed with official documents;
 - comply with the Charter of the University;
 - comply with the internal regulations.
- 3.3. For violation by a student of the obligations stipulated by the Charter of the University and the rules of its internal regulations, disciplinary sanctions may be applied to him, up to expulsion from a higher educational institution.

IV. PROCEDURE FOR ACCEPTANCE, AMENDMENT AND SUPPLEMENTATION OF THE CODE

- 4.1. Students are required to know and follow this Code. Ignorance or disagreement with ethical standards is not an excuse for unethical behavior.
- 4.2. The Code is developed by the Rector's Office, reviewed and adopted by the Academic Council, agreed by the President and approved by the Rector of the University.
- 4.4. Changes and additions to this Code are made in the same order as its adoption, which is communicated to all students.

V. LIABILITY FOR BREACHING THE CODE BY STUDENTS

- 5.1. Students' compliance with the provisions of the Code is taken into account when deciding whether to send them to an internship, when transferring to other educational institutions, in a description issued after graduation, in recommendations for admission to graduate school, as well as when deciding whether to encourage or impose disciplinary sanctions.
- 5.2. Deans, heads of departments and teachers are obliged to monitor compliance with the rules of this Code
- 5.3. In case of non-compliance with this Code, disciplinary measures are applied. The teacher has the right not to admit the student to the lesson. For systematic non-fulfillment of the provisions of

the Code by the decision of the department meeting, the student is given a reprimand with entry into the personal file and analysis of the circumstances at the rectorate.
