REGULATIONS ON CLINICAL BASES

This regulation on the Clinical Bases of the Salymbekov University Institution (hereinafter referred to as the University) was created in accordance with the Law of the Kyrgyz Republic "On healthcare organizations in the Kyrgyz Republic", the Civil Code of the Kyrgyz Republic, the regulation on the procedure for interaction of healthcare organizations with higher and secondary vocational educational institutions for issues of practical training of students, approved by the Decree of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic dated from August 5, 2008 № 425.

I. General provisions

- 1.1. Clinical bases of the University provide medical and sanitary assistance to citizens in the Kyrgyz Republic, interact with the structural divisions of the University on the practical training of students.
- 1.2. The university has its own clinics to organize practical training for students, conduct industrial practices and organize medical examinations of students and employees.
- 1.3. Practical training of students, conducting industrial practices, are carried out on the basis of their own clinical bases, as well as others assigned to the University as clinical bases.
- 1.3. The issues of placement of departments (divisions, cycles, etc.) of the University located in the buildings of clinical bases are regulated by the Ministry of Health of the Kyrgyz Republic.
- 1.4. Clinical bases of the University (hereinafter the clinical base) can be healthcare organizations, regardless of ownership and departmental affiliation, which provide various types of medical care and have a sufficient level of material and technical equipment and human resources necessary to master modern methods of organizational, methodological, scientific research, educational and medical-diagnostic work, and providing high-quality training and retraining of specialists in the healthcare system, scientific personnel.
- 1.5. Disputes arising between the clinical bases and the University on the practical training of students and on-the-job training are resolved through negotiations between the parties.

II. Tasks of clinical bases

- 2.1. The main tasks of clinical bases are:
- implementation of continuous training of specialists in accordance with the State educational standards;
- development and implementation of effective methods of prevention, diagnosis, treatment and rehabilitation of patients into the system of practical healthcare;
- creating conditions for the University to conduct scientific research and organize the educational process using modern medical equipment.
 - 2.2. The management of the clinical base provides:
- creating the necessary conditions for students with the provision of the required number of classrooms and the possibility of using equipment and equipment of the clinic in the educational process;
- availibility of conditions for full-fledged participation in the treatment process for the University staff.
- 2.3. Clinical bases have right to hospitalize thematic patients necessary for the educational process and scientific work.

III. Organization of the work of the clinical base

3.1. The management of the clinical base is carried out by the head (chief physician, director) of the healthcare organization.

- 3.2. The management of the clinical base and the University are responsible and assist in organizing the educational process and practical training of students.
- 3.3. Doctors of the clinical base who have a scientific degree, the first / highest qualification category, have the right to engage in teaching activities and part-time job at the University.
 - 3.4. Head of the Department of the University:
- is guided by regulatory acts in the field of protecting the health of citizens and education, the charter and internal regulatory legal acts of the University, the charter of the healthcare organization, these Regulations;
- interacts with the head and deputy head of the healthcare organization for medical work, the head of the department for organization issues, are jointly and severally responsible for providing medical diagnostic, advisory assistance and organizing the educational process in the departments of healthcare organizations;
- performs compulsory medical and advisory work on the basis of an agreement with a healthcare organization.
- 3.5. Associate professors, assistants of the University along with pedagogical and research work:
- carry out medical and advisory work as doctors or consultants by agreement and are guided by the internal regulations of the clinical base;
- are responsible for the quality of medical activities and the safety of assigned educational premises and equipment.
- 3.6. Doctoral students, graduate students perform medical work in accordance with the contract between the healthcare organization and the University.
- 3.7. Carrying out repair work of the educational premises of the clinical base, allocated for educational organizations, is carried out by the University. Payment for utilities, allocated premises for educational purposes, is carried out in accordance with the agreement between the University and the healthcare organization.
- 3.8. The management of the University is responsible for the quality of medical and advisory assistance provided by the staff of the departments of the University, damage to medical equipment during training sessions, as well as in case of violations of the norms and requirements of labor protection and fire safety rules by students.
